For 15mm armies, "standard mounting" means 4 infantry on a 1.5" X 0.5" base, 3 cavalry on a 1.5" X 1" base, and 1 gun plus gunners on a 1" X 1.5" base. Light infantry are mounted on half-sized 2-figure bases. For Pike and shot, musketeers are mounted 3 on a stand, not 4.

For 25mm armies, standard basing means heavy infantry are 4 figures at 15mm frontage, missile troops are 3 figures at 20mm frontage, and cavalry is 3 figures at 20mm frontage. There are of course all sorts of make-change stands.

MY 1/72 WW2 and Microarmor collections are mostly single-based.

Seven Years War

When I paint Seven years War figures, I think of *Barry Lindon* and those other great movies set in that general period. I also have an abiding love of the Austrians, so I can really get into hating Fred the Gross.

It's funny how the history books always emphasize that this was "the Age of Reason", where armies fought each other in neat lines and stayed away from the civilians. It was not like that! The Prussians committed all sorts of atrocities in Saxony, such as sending Pandours to burn Dresden as a punishment for something or other (I think over in Germany that Saxons and Prussians still kind of dislike each other because of what went on back then). There was also a lot of religious hatred between the Protestant Prussians, the Catholic Austrians, and the Orthodox Russians. The Prussians were fond of burning Catholic churches, and the Austrian irregulars like to beat Protestant merchants or travelers to death on the roads.

Anyway...

My biggest collection is of course the Austrians, but I am also starting a small Russian army. I've got it about halfway done. My friend Terry Dehrkoop has a lot of Prussians painted up. On the rare occasions

when we meet to game SYW, we usually use *Age of Reason*. My figures for SYW are almost entirely Old Glory; I think I might have a few Minifigs, but I'm not sure.

Russians

The Russians are a small army; I bought the packs on a lark at an *Enfilade* convention in (I think) 1996. They sat forlorn in my painting trays for several years, until my interest came back around to the Eighteenth Century. I've got them about halfway painted as of this writing, 8 battalions to go. The units are all Old Glory, painted for a "standard" army, not Army of Observation. The figures have a wash technique for their green coats, a fair amount of shading, plus some black-lining.

Figures are on standard basing. Units are 16 infantry, 12 cavalry, or 3 gun models.

American Revolution

AWI is really about my favorite period of history; I love the romance of the times, with the neat colonial farms and plantations along the coast, and the vast, wild interior peopled by hostile Indians. There were important battles with as many as 15,000 men per side, as at Brandywine and Long Island, down to less than 500, as at Kaskaskia.

I already had a large 25mm collection for this period when I started my 15's, back in the late 1980's. Back then there were several other gamers interested in this period, but only in 15mm. So I happily started painting up some Americans to go with their British. I had already bought a lot of Musket Miniatures in 25mm. I liked these figures pretty well because they covered a lot of unusual troops, and you could even buy figures with individual specialized headgear; so it was natural for me to get a few packs of their 15mm figures. If I ever do British in 15mm, I'll use Musket Miniatures. Their figures are perhaps not as crisp as some other lines, but they have a certain "toy soldier" quality that appeals to me for this period.

Most of my AWI figures are Musket Miniatures; some are "New" Minifigs, some are from manufacturers now out of business whose names escape me. My AWI's are based mostly on 1.5" X 0.5" stands, 4 figures per stand. Light infantry and rifles are on half-sized 2-figure stands. Cavalry are mounted 2 figures on 1.5" X 1" stands. Guns are mounted 1 model plus 4 gunners on 1" X 1.5" stands.

All units except the rifles and some militia have flags (which are sometimes even correct for the unit). Uniforms of some units are conjectural. Most units are black-lined; some show variations in leggings and pant colors to lend variety.

"Age of Sail" Ships

I have not used my ships for a long time, but they bring back a lot of memories for me. I met Dave Richmond, one of my closest friends, back in the early 1980's, playing this era. Dave is a naval fanatic and has a much larger collection than me. He had just moved to Seattle, and fortunately we both loved the Ship of the Line rules (and still do...). So we played a lot of battles with these little models, and one abortive campaign that I tried to run.

The idea of the campaign was that several nations were trying to gain control of a set of ports in some pseudo-Caribbean Sea. I remember the first turn, Dave lined all of his ships up about 20 miles apart – just close enough that their topmasts were visible to each other, and scouted the entire map in two turns. That drove me crazy, but it made perfect sense. It also taught me that a naval campaign is *not* like a land campaign, and I had a lot more research to do to get a sea campaign set up properly!

All of these are Valiant 1:1200 scale, which I don't think you can get any more. They are reasonably well painted, and have wire rigging helping to hold the masts in place. All are mounted on 0.75" X 1.5" bases, to cover two standard squares on an SOL-gridded game surface.
